RELOADING DATA: 8mm JAPANESE NAMBU

Notes:

- Always have your gun checked by a qualified gunsmith before shooting.
- 2. On guns with oversize bores, you may find that best accuracy is obtained with heaviest loadings. Approach these with caution.
- 3. If the expander plug in your reloading dies opens the neck of the case too much, the bullet will upset when it hits the feed ramp. It can be dangerous to shoot those rounds where the bullet has upset. Turn the expander down until it will barely enter a sized case. Do not alter the belling shoulder.
- 4. Bell the mouth of the case just enough that a bullet will sit on the case. Most seating dies do not have a crimp shoulder, so an excess bell cannot be crimped closed. The excess bell may cause malfunctions or bullet upset.
- 5. Type 94 Guns will generally function with somewhat less powder than Type 14 or Papa Nambu's.
